CHANGE LEAD

All in for Change is an inclusive programme bringing people together to help end homelessness in Scotland. It is driven by a Change Team of people from across the country.

The Change Team are experts in what homelessness looks like on the ground, bringing together diverse knowledge from people with lived experience of homelessness and those who work in a frontline support or advice role.

OPPORTUNITIES AVAILABLE

There are two types of opportunities:

1. Change Lead who currently works in a frontline advice or support role

We'd love to hear from you. We'll need your organisation to sponsor your time and travel expenses and approve your involvement of around eight hours per month. We will provide lunch and refreshments when we are able to gather together again.

2. Change Lead who currently works in a frontline advice or support role, who *also* has experience of homelessness.

Some Change Leads currently work in the sector and also have experience of homelessness. We really value this insight. We'll need your organisation to sponsor your time and travel expenses and approve your involvement of around eight hours per month. We will provide lunch and refreshments when we are able to gather together again.

WHO ARE YOU?

You will work in a direct support or advice role alongside people. It is important that the Change Team is made up of diverse voices – reflecting many types of people affected by homelessness in Scotland. We are especially interested in applications from individuals from traditionally underrepresented groups. It doesn't matter which type of organisation you work alongside, or for. It could be a charity, a council, health provider or housing association. What is much more important is:

for everyone living or working with homelessness



you give off good vibes and are non-judgemental, respectful and open minded



you've got a way with words/gift of the gab/good chat

and don't mind an occasional challenging conversation



you're willing to learn and listen to people

about the Ending Homelessness Together Plan



you have a connection

to people and /or groups involved in homelessness



you're not camera-shy

- We present at webinars, conferences and events.
- We are leading our own national consultation.
