1 General

Creative Natives provides holistic, person-centred support, alongside a flexible menu of creative experience activities, which support young people who are, or have, struggled at school. They often face challenges when trying to progress onto further education, training, or employment and benefit from experiencing the connection between creativity, wellbeing and good mental health.

Our key workers deliver comprehensive and nurturing support by building trusted relationships with each participant. Our way of working is assets-based, guided and led by each young person's interests and aspirations. We offer support on a 1 to 1 basis and in small groups.

In a safe and supported environment, the young people (aged 14 to 24) are able to develop and acquire new skills, build confidence and resilience through the medium of creativity in all its forms until they are ready to move on.

Cyrenians requires all staff to be flexible in their approach and to display care, respect and a non-judgmental approach, being prepared to work tenaciously and imaginatively towards successful outcomes.

2 Tasks and Responsibilities

Work closely with the Creative Natives team to:

- Provide excellent one-to-one support to young people using the service
- Enable young people to engage with the project by developing trusted relationships and supporting them to be creative
- Deliver creative/wellbeing activities that promote personal development
- Offer person-centred support to young people and family members who are experiencing issues affecting their wellbeing
- Help young people to be fully engaged through a non-judgemental and nurturing approach to the activities.
